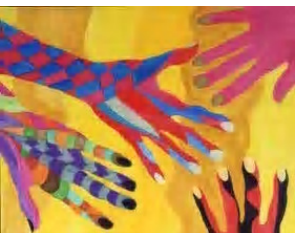

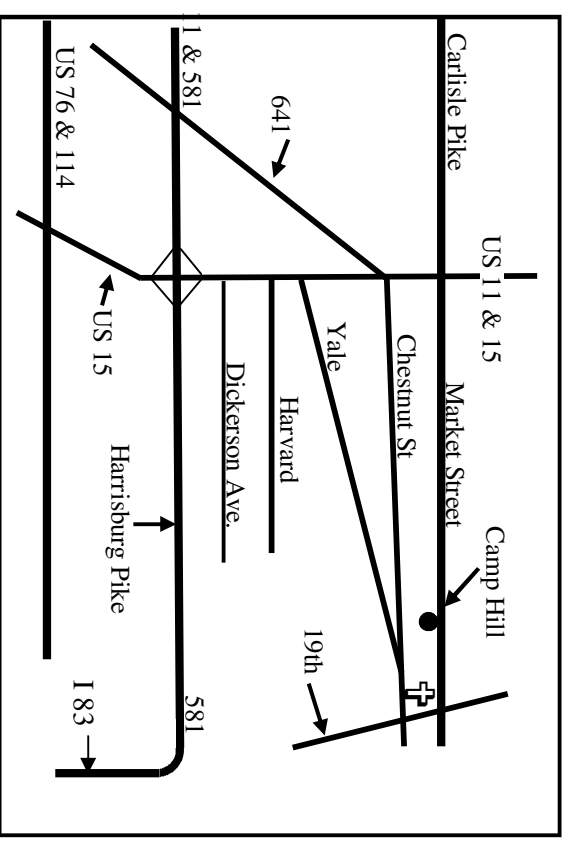

Come to the Table

“*Come to the Table... in Remembrance of Me*” is the theme that will permeate the activities of this Region 8 gathering. In addition, the festival worship will also draw from the varied traditions within the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. We will move within this theme as it is beautifully expressed in the words of the hymn writer, Clair Cloninger:



Come to the table of mercy
Prepared with the wine and the bread
All who are hungry and thirsty
Come and your souls will be fed

Come at the Lord's invitation
Receive from his nailed hand.
Eat of the bread of salvation;
Drink of the blood of the lamb.

Orientation will be held in three half-hour sessions beginning at 5:30. Dinner will be on your own.

Opening Worship, a celebration of the Great Commission, is at 7 PM with **Dr. Rafael Malpica-Padilla**, ELCA Executive Director, Global Missions, Preacher. The musical setting will be an expression of the global church. A reception and conversations with invited guests will round out the evening activities.



A two-day opportunity for congregations considering global ministry. **Spend** time with experts and resources from various domestic and global ministries around the nation and world. **Enjoy** a festive, music-filled plenary and programming that will lead your congregation to a better understanding of God's activity in the world around us.
